We are pleased to provide the following Quantity Take-Off and Cost Estimate for Site Work activities at the above referenced project. Our proposal is in accordance with plans entitled, Preliminary / Final Major Site Plan & Subdivision Commercial Dealership Civil Plan Sheets 1 through 22 dated June 23, 2021 and having no revisions; as prepared by Engineering Partners, Inc.

General Exclusions:

- 1. Construction Layout, Survey Control, Benchmarks, Property Monuments, and As-Builts.
- 2. Engineering or Geotechnical Compaction Testing or Services.
- 3. Existing Utility Removal or Relocation.
- 4. Excessive Dewatering, or Well Pointing.
- 5. Rock Excavation or Lost Time Due to Inadequate Rock Excavation / Blasting by others.
- 6. Removal or Replacement of Unsuitable Soils.
- 7. Moisture Conditioning of on-site soils not within 3% of Optimum Moisture content.
- 8. Existing Foundation Removal or Structure Demolition.
- 9. Sinkhole Remediation.
- 10. Site Lighting, Landscaping, Amended Soils, Sodding, or Permanent Seeding.
- 11. Handling Excess Soils Generated by Other Trades.
- 12. Screening or Amending existing Topsoil (if available) for reuse. Assuming all topsoil needed will be imported.
- 13. Importing Clay for Basin Core Trench.
- 14. Handling or Testing of Hazmat Materials or Removal of Existing Debris.
- 15. Importing Class II Material for Trench Backfill.

Qualifications:

- 1. Existing Site Surface material to be incorporated in to site cuts and fills.
- 2. Subgrade for Topsoil Return is calculated at minimum 4" in all areas.
- 3. All proposed utilities terminate 5' from face of building.
- 4. Jack & Bore is based on 24" Steel Casing.
- 5. Class II Material for trench backfill is to be onsite excavated material. Importing Select Material for trench backfill is not included.
- 6. Soil De-Compaction / Mitigation Evaluation to be performed by others.
- 7. Utility Relocations due to conflict with Sewer Boring is not included.
- 8. Asphalt pricing is based on October 2021 Index of \$513.00.
- 9. Earthwork volumes are based on existing piles being removed prior to start. Existing Piles are not included in cut fill volumes.
